Lower-back Mount 4" (100 mm) dial







- 2. Maximum working pressure is restricted by the end connection.
- 3. Not all the dial ranges and end connections are available for all configurations.
- 4. Primary scale should be taken as a priority than the secondary scale (reference only). Example: If the scale range can reach up to 200 psi, the maximum value for primary scale (psi) is 200, while the maximum value for secondary scale (MPa) shall be 1.3 or 1.4.
